

# Victorious Walk Bible Reading Plan

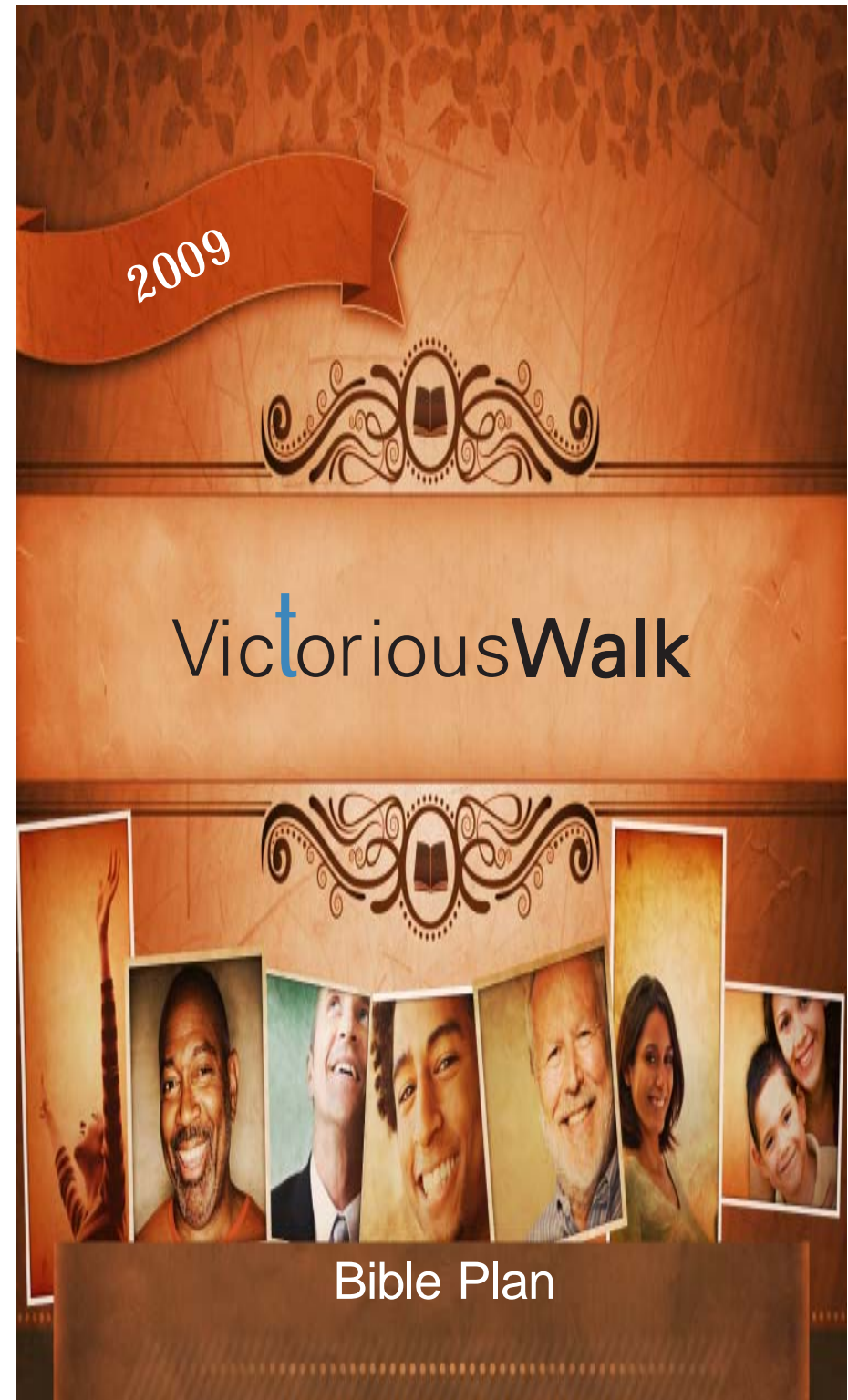
is designed to help you be victorious in practicing your home discipleship. This plan encourages homes to set aside 15 minutes a day for intentional practices of home discipleship.

**15 minutes a day—**

*Bible Reading 5 minutes.*

*Bible Memory 5 minutes.*

*Worship and Prayer 5 minutes.*

The Victorious Walk Bible Plan is designed to help churches encourage their members and attendees to be victorious in actually practicing home discipleship habits in the home.

### **Bible Reading (5 minutes):**

We encourage reading one chapter a day of the **Victorious Walk Bible Reading Plan**.

If you have a family, try to get the family together for this reading. Many families get together for dinner and do their reading during or after dinner. After the Bible reading, use the **Victorious Walk Crossword Puzzle** to review what was read. If you have young children, set aside some time to color the weekly **Victorious Walk Coloring Pages** focusing on the stories of Genesis.

### **Bible Memory (5 minutes):**

Bible memory is becoming a lost practice for believers and their families. **The Victorious Walk 2009 Memory Challenge** encourages your family in the Psalm Challenge.

### **Worship and Prayer (5 min.):**

Singing and praying are very important practices of communing with God. Many churches have a song or hymn of the month. All homes are encouraged to end their time of Bible reading and memorization in prayer.

### **Other Features—**

#### **Co-ordinated Preaching Schedule—**

The pastors will coordinate their preaching schedule to generally connect to the Victorious Walk Bible reading plan. Some features of the plan will make for

stimulating message topics on Sunday.

On Sunday, the book of Genesis is opened at home. On Wednesday, Wisdom literature is read, and during the rest of the week the entire New Testament is read. This provides a pastor, seekers and growing believers with ample variety of texts and topics through out the year.

**Coordinate Church Activities—**All activities at are encouraged to begin with reading the passage for that day.

**Utilize the Crossword Puzzles—** Crossword puzzles feature four questions each day that connect to the Bible reading plan. After you do the Bible reading of the day, ask the questions to keep everyone listening.

**Utilize the Coloring Pages—**The coloring pages are great tools to support young children in connecting to the Bible reading.

**Encourage the Bible Memory Challenge—**The Bible memory challenge will be fun to implement. Individuals, couples, or families could be asked to recite their memory passage at a worship service or another event. The challenge passages are taken from the book of Psalms.
